The online exam is an adapted version of some of the moderated exam questions (Q1-Q43) in the form of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and short-answer questions. All can be automatically graded.

There are two parts to this online assessment:

First part: 20 random multiple-choice questions (MCQs) out of 40 moderated and external examiner's approved MCQs. [40 marks]

Second part: 3 long questions, each 20 marks [total 60 marks]. Students should answer all three long questions.

I have divided MCQs in part one, to two parts of easier and harder questions to make sure all students answer same ratio of easy and hard questions. There are 30 questions in easier MCQ category, 15 to be randomly chosen and 10 harder MCQs, 5 to be randomly selected for students to answer. So, all students will be given 15 easier and 5 harder MCQs.

Mix of drop-down menu (MCQs) and short answers are used for the second part of the exam.

Question 21 has 3 variations with the same level of the difficulty, one to be randomly selected for each student.
